

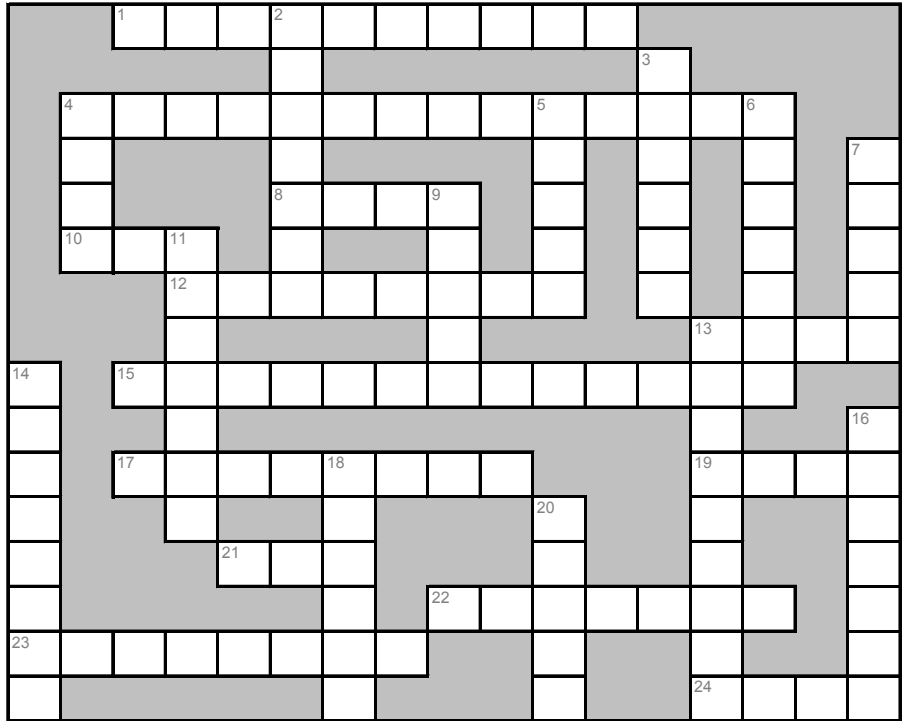
# Railway Coastal Museum Crossword Challenge
